Things to know before arrival

Esrum Abbey provides the following under the market:

- Water and access to toilets
- Access to electricity available upon request
- Sleeping area in common dormitory at the Mill Loft - If you don't want to sleep at the market place
- Firewood
- If you do not have meals included in your contract, you can buy meals during the market: breakfast and lunch on Saturday and Sunday and dinner Saturday - for a total of 250 DKK (Including VAT) per person or/and opportunity to buy food from stalls during the market. If you have meals included in your contract, and would like to join the dinner Saturday night, you have to pay a small fee on 25 DDK pr. person.

How to get to Esrum

Address: Esrum Abbey, Klostergade 11-12, 3230 Graested, Denmark

Esrum Abbey is located in Northern Zealand approximately 50 km north of Copenhagen.

From Copenhagen and further south take the freeway E47 to exit 4 for Kvistgaard / Hornbæk. Then turn left towards Hornbæk and drive approximately 6 km before you turn to the left again. Then you just follow the road signs leading to Esrum.

Parking is at the parking lot at Watermill – you have to take the small road leading from Frederiksværkvej.
